Program Process

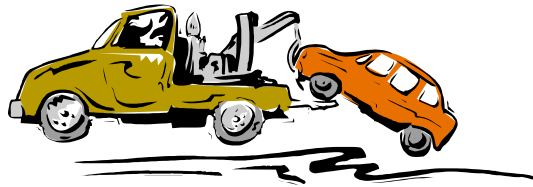
Scenario 1:

If you are the property owner, live on property and the registered owner of the unwanted vehicle(s) please do the following:

- Please sign the "Request Removal Form"
- Mail form to your local Code Enforcement office (see listing on reverse)

Removal Process

- A Code Enforcement representative will visit your property to identify the vehicle(s) you requested to be removed
- Vehicle list is reviewed for DMV identification
- Removal Order is sent to a towing company. The towing company removes vehicles within 15 days of receiving removal order.



Scenario 2:

If you are the property owner, live on your property and not the registered owner of the unwanted vehicles do the following:

- Please sign the "Request Removal Form"
- Mail form to your local Code Enforcement office (see listing on reverse)

Removal Process

- A Code Enforcement representative will visit your property to identify the vehicle(s) you requested to be removed.
- Vehicle list is reviewed for DMV identification
- Legal/Registered Owner is notified with a 10 day notice to respond.
- During this waiting period the legal/registered owner will have the opportunity to remove, fix or store the vehicle(s) in a permitted structure.
- After the 10 day waiting period has expired a removal order is sent to a towing company.
- The towing company will remove the vehicle(s) within 15 days of receiving the removal order.

If you decide that you want to keep the vehicles:

- Store vehicle in a fully enclosed permitted structure or the vehicle has to be fixed and operable.

Note:

- **Vehicle removals may be reviewed on a case by case basis; as not all scenarios will apply. Based on Code Enforcement discretion.**
- **Legally mandated process can take approximately 45-90 days from start to completion.**
- **Boats, watercraft, and travel trailers do not qualify.**
