ANZA TIRE DISPOSAL DAY

Saturday, April 11th, 2009
8:00 am – 2:00 pm

Riverside County Board of Supervisor Jeff Stone, Anza Valley Chamber of Commerce and Riverside County Code Enforcement sponsored the second Tire Disposal Day in Anza on April 11, 2009.

This event was paid for by Third District County Supervisor Jeff Stone and the Waste Tire Enforcement Grant from the California Integrated Waste Management Board, which was received by Riverside County Code Enforcement.

On Saturday, April 11th, this one-day event was opened to all Anza Valley residents. Three 48-ft trailers were delivered. By 1:00 pm all of the trailers were full. A local auto shop was available on-site for rim removal. The number of tires brought in with rims was overwhelming and although he got most of them done, some had to be turned away.

Supervisor Stone offered this to the community as a fundraiser to help improve parks and baseball fields. Five dollars was given back to the community for each tire that was received.

Anza Valley Chamber of Commerce showed their support through advertising the collection date and by recruiting volunteers to help unload vehicles. Local high school student Matt Davis worked tirelessly all day loading and stacking not only vehicle tires, but heavy tractor and truck tires as well.

The participation from the community was overwhelming and much heavier than expected. 2174 tires were collected!!
