

SUPERVISORIAL DISTRICT NO. 2.

This district shall consist of territory in the county included within the following described boundaries:

1. **Beginning** at the point of intersection of the Westerly boundary of the County of Riverside and the centerline of Bedford Canyon Road;
2. Thence Northeasterly along said centerline to a point of intersection with the North line of Section 29, T4S, R6W;
3. Thence East along Section lines to a point of intersection with the centerline of Temescal Canyon Road;
4. Thence Northerly along said centerline of Temescal Canyon Road to a point of intersection with the Southerly city boundary of the City of Corona as it exists today;
5. Thence Easterly, Southerly, Easterly and Northerly along said city boundary of the City of Corona to a point of intersection with the West line of Section 15, T4S, R6W;
6. Thence Northerly along the West lines of Sections 15 and 10, T4S, R6W, to a point of intersection with the city boundary of the City of Corona;
7. Thence Easterly and Northerly along said city boundary of the City of Corona to a point of intersection with the North line of Section 34, T3S, R6W;
8. Thence West along said North line, also being the Northerly city boundary of the City of Corona to the Southwest corner of Parcel 2 as shown by Map on file in Book 103, Pages 1 through 5, inclusive, of Parcel Maps, records of the Recorder of Riverside County, California;
9. Thence Northerly along the Westerly lines of Parcels 1 and 2 of said Parcel Map to a point of intersection with the centerline of Indiana Avenue;
10. Thence Southwesterly along said centerline of Indiana Avenue to a point of intersection with the Westerly city boundary line of the City of Riverside;
11. Thence Northerly along said Westerly city boundary of the City of Riverside as it exists today, through all its various courses to a point of intersection with the centerline of Arlington Avenue;
12. Thence Westerly along said centerline of Arlington Avenue to a point of intersection with the common boundary between said City of Riverside and the City of Norco as it exists today;
13. Thence Northerly along said common boundary and the Easterly line of said City of Norco as it exists today to the Southerly line of the Santa Ana River;
14. Thence Northeasterly and Easterly along said Southerly line of the Santa Ana River to a point of intersection with the centerline of the Union Pacific Railroad;
15. Thence Southeasterly along said centerline of the Union Pacific Railroad to a point of intersection with the centerline of Mountain View Avenue;
16. Thence Westerly along said centerline of Mountain View Avenue to a point of intersection with the centerline of Hillside Avenue;
17. Thence Southerly and Southwesterly along said centerline of Hillside Avenue to a point of intersection with the centerline of Arlington Avenue;
18. Thence Westerly along said centerline of Arlington Avenue to a point of intersection with the centerline of Adams Street;
19. Thence Southeasterly along said centerline of Adams Street to a point of intersection with the centerline of State Highway 91;
20. Thence Northeasterly along said centerline of State Highway 91 and the centerline of Interstate 215 to a point of intersection with the Southeasterly prolongation of the Southwesterly line of Annexation Number 77 to the City of Riverside, recorded August 2, 1993 as Instrument Number 298327, records of said Recorder;
21. Thence Northwesterly along said Southeasterly prolongation and the Southwesterly line of said Annexation Number 77 to the Southwest corner of said Annexation Number 77, said corner being on the Northwesterly right of way line of West La Cadena Drive (50 feet wide);
22. Thence Northwesterly, Northeasterly and Northerly along said city boundary of the City of Riverside as it exists today, to a point of intersection with the Northerly boundary of the County of Riverside;
23. Thence Westerly, Northerly, Westerly and Southerly along said boundary of the County of Riverside to the **Point of Beginning**.
