**ATTENTION Professional Consulting Archaeologists:**

The next scheduled County Cultural Resources consultant certification class will be held on the following date:

**April 12, 2012** (registration deadline is April 9, 2012)

While the classes are open to all archaeologists and interested parties, all professional-level archaeologists desiring to submit technical reports to the County of Riverside must be certified with the County. Certification includes having attended an orientation/professional topics training session once every other year as well as having professional qualifications and experience reviewed and accepted by the County. Certification is valid for two years, unless revoked. Those with expired certifications, who have been determined eligible to certify reports, will be removed from the County's Cultural Resources Consultant List and not permitted to certify reports submitted to the County until they are recertified. Maximum capacity for the class is 45 people. Registration is on a "First-come, First-served" basis. Each class begins at 9:30 a.m. and ends by 4:30 p.m., and will be held at the Desert Permit Assistance Center, 38686 El Cerrito Road, Palm Desert. **Registration fee is \$80 check or cashier's check made out to the County of Riverside.** More information about registration will be posted on the TLMA website and emailed to consultants currently listed, in the near future.

The morning session will include an orientation to the report requirements and expectations for cultural resources investigations by County staff, as well as a presentation on late prehistoric Luiseno village footprint by cultural resources staff from Pechanga Band. The afternoon seminar will be lead by archaeologist Sherri Gust, on "Prehistoric Food Consumption: protein residue – botany and faunal".
