Road work closes Cajalco Road in the evenings through October

Evening construction work will close Cajalco Road near Lake Mathews starting Aug. 5 and road work will continue for the next two months.

Cajalco Road will be closed between Temescal Canyon Road and La Sierra Avenue from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. The \$1.68 million roadway project will repave the thoroughfare and add two truck turnouts. A new traffic signal will be added at the corner of Cajalco Road and La Sierra Avenue. The closures will be in effect in the evenings and Cajalco Road will remain open to traffic during the day.

The project will complete road improvements on Cajalco Road that spanned from El Sobrante Road to the Corona city limits. Funding for the construction comes from the voter-approved Measure A, which added a half-cent to sales tax for local transportation projects. Construction is expected to be completed in October.

Residents and businesses along the construction zone will have access to their property, but the road will remain closed for through traffic during the closure hours. Motorists are asked to be careful and obey all directions near the construction zone. For more information about the closure or the project, contact (888) 863-1757.
